


City Centre Resident Survey

A member from the FACTSNet Spruce Grove team put together a survey to see what the residents thought of the ARP. Two members from the team went door to door to nearly all of the homes. There are 98 single family homes in the ARP zone but we only made it to 88 of those homes. Out of those 88, we were able to speak to 39 homes. 49% (19% total) of the people that were spoken to know about the ARP and were knowledgeable about what the city's plans are, while 18% (7% total) had no knowledge about the ARP whatsoever. 28% (11% total) had either heard or read something about the ARP but had very little knowledge about the city's plans. The remaining 5% (2% total) declined to do the survey.

95% (37% total) of the residents spoken to have no intention or plan to move anytime soon.

Below is a chart displaying the responses we received from the residents.



One of the questions asked on the survey was, "What do you enjoy about living in the downtown area?" The most common responses were privacy, community, space, amenities and services close by in addition to the quietness.

Many residents expressed that they've lived in the area for a long time, their home was inherited by their parents and/or grandparents as well as they have invested a lot of money into the homes by renovations or making expansions. From those that we spoke to, an overwhelming majority of the residents are against the plan as it stands currently.
